Michael W. Fried, MD is Professor of Medicine and Director of Hepatology at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.

He completed his residency in internal medicine and fellowship in gastroenterology at the State University of New York in Syracuse.

Dr. Fried was started his research career at the dawn of the discovery of HCV while serving as Hepatology Fellow in the Liver Diseases Section at the NIH between 1990-1993.

Since then, he has been the principal investigator on many clinical trials of therapies for HBV and HCV. Dr. Fried has had continuous NIH funding for more than 15 years as principal investigator on several NIH cooperative clinical trials, and currently serves as co-chair of the NIH Hepatitis B Research Network.

He is also co-principal investigator of the HCV-TARGET network to study the real-world experience with therapies for hepatitis C.

Dr. Fried is a member of the AASLD Governing Board and will assume the role of President in 2019.
