



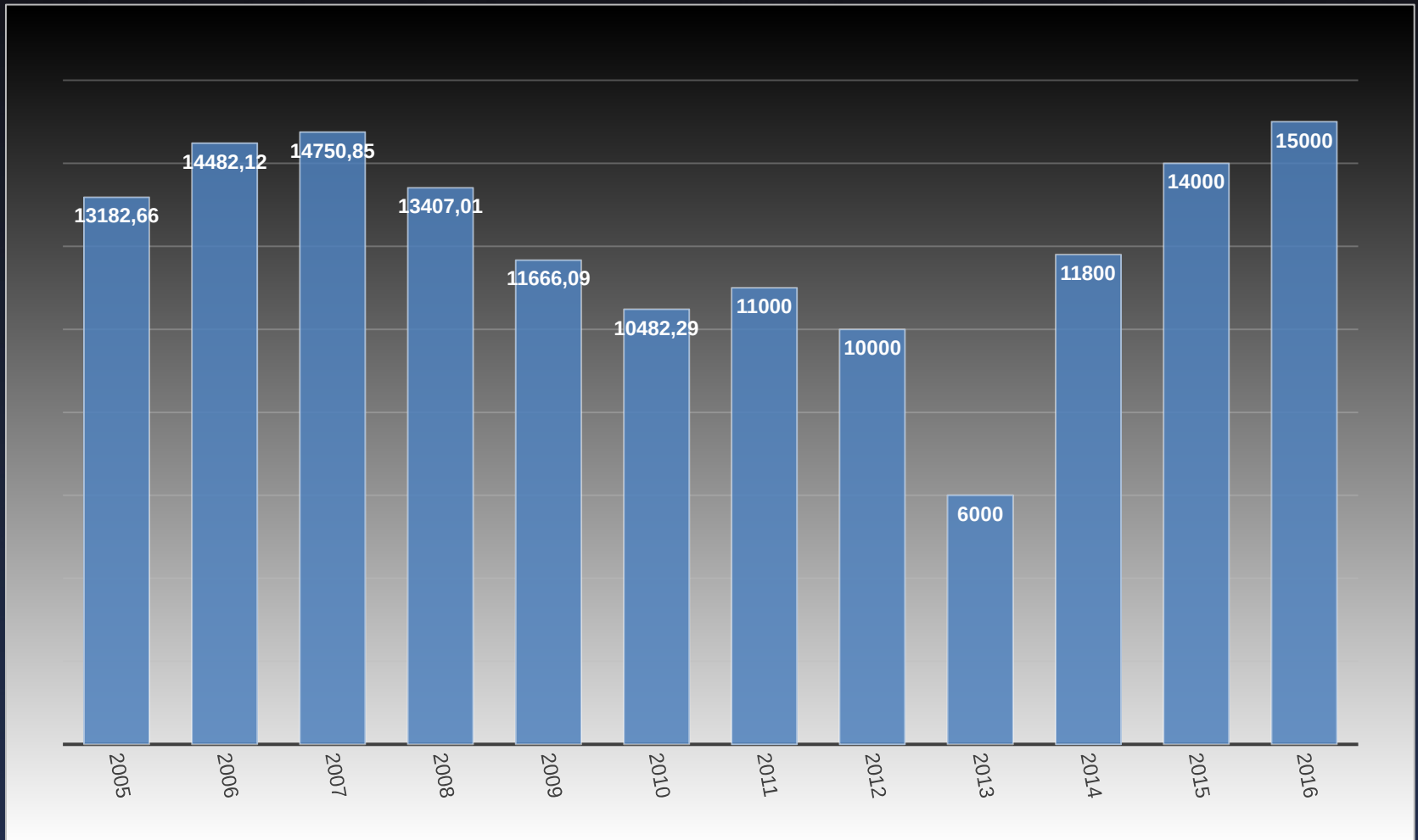

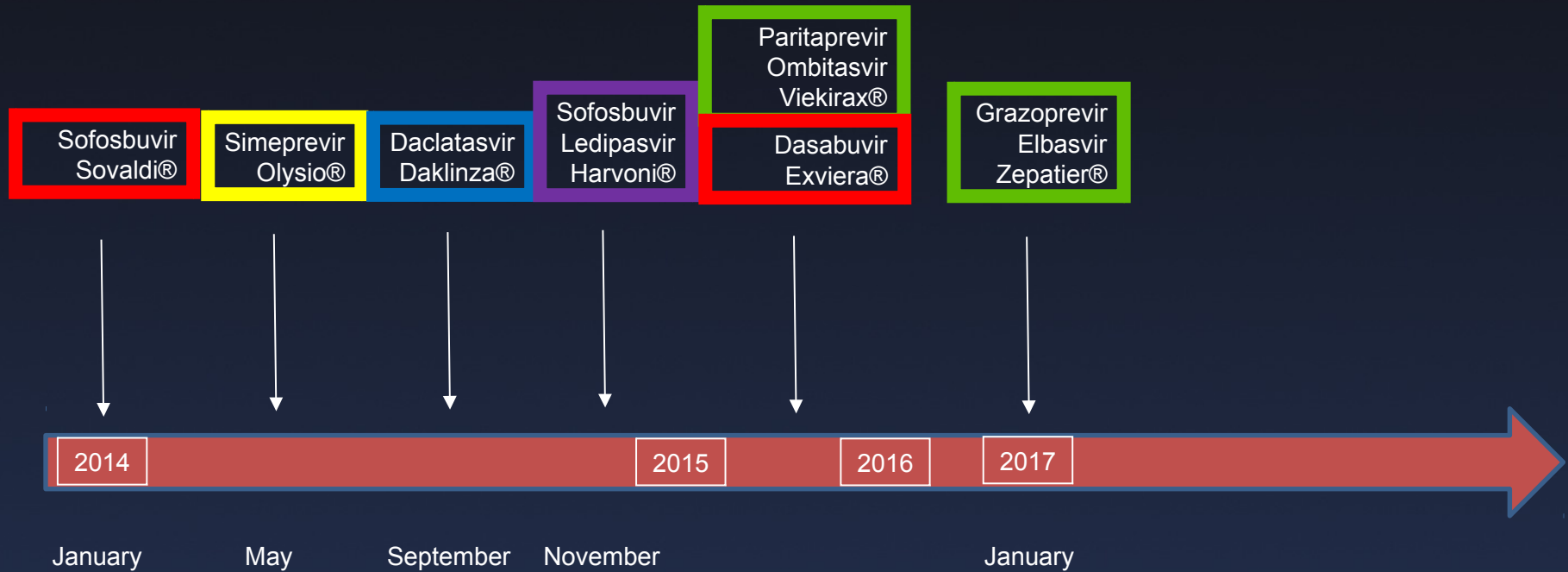
Current situation of hepatitis C in France

- ✓ Prevalence : 0.6 – 0.7%
- ✓ Total number of patients : 200,000
- ✓ Number of liver transplantations : 74 (5.5%)
- ✓ Total number of patients treated so far : 50,000
- ✓ Total number of patients treated per year : 15,000

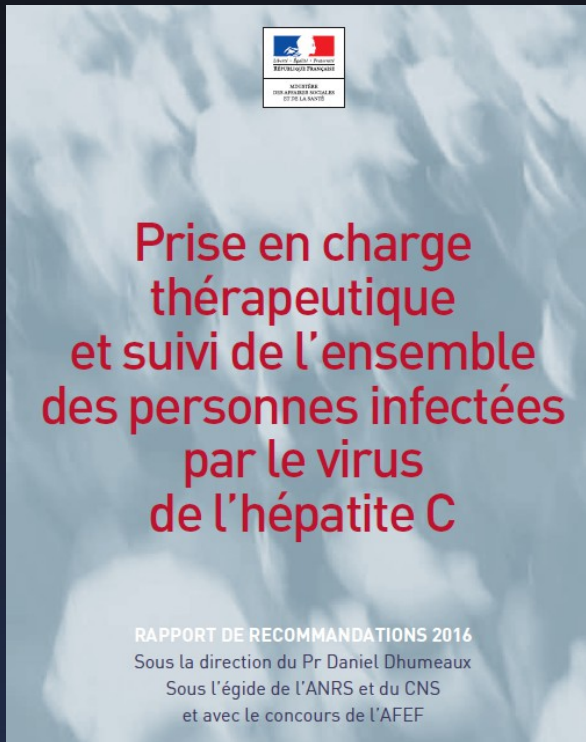

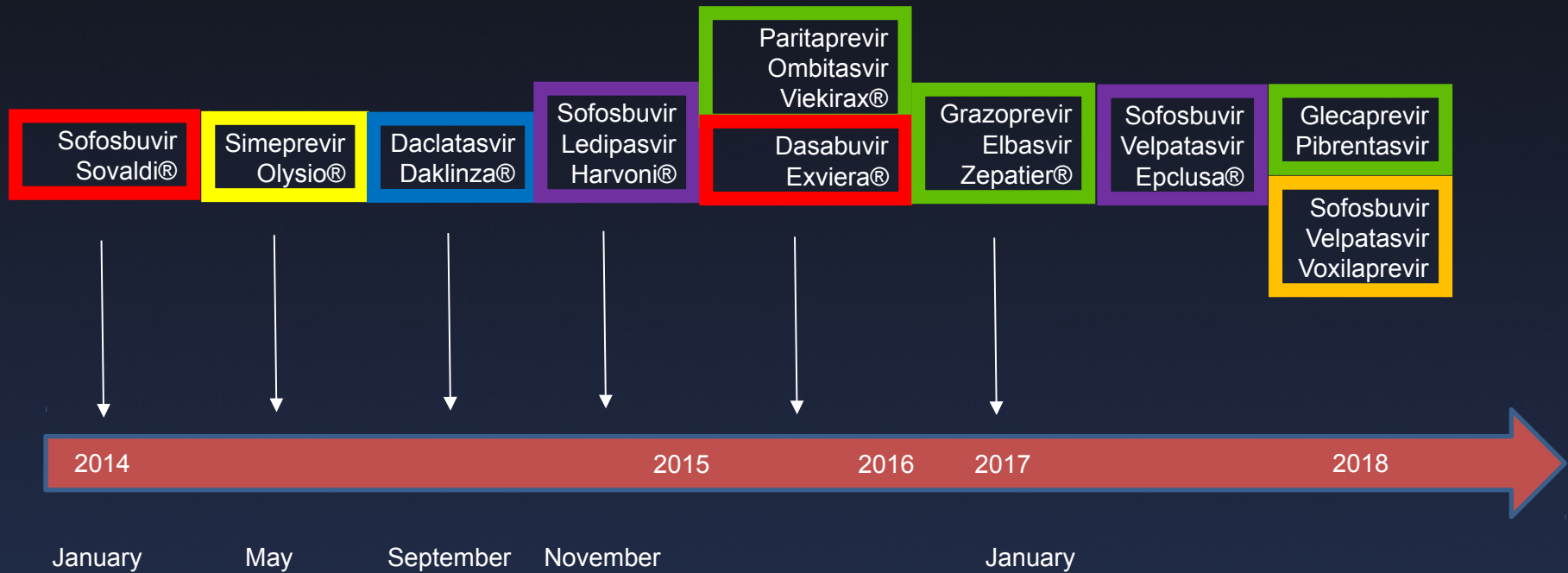

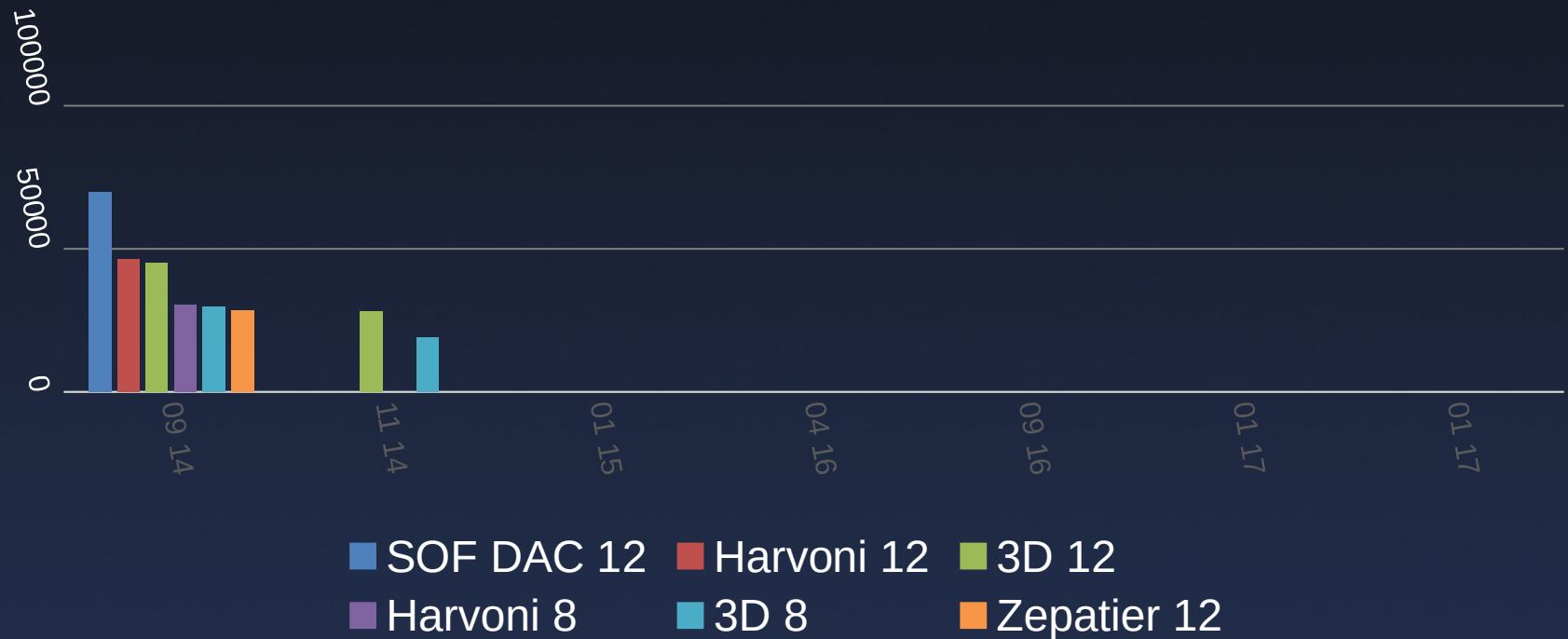
