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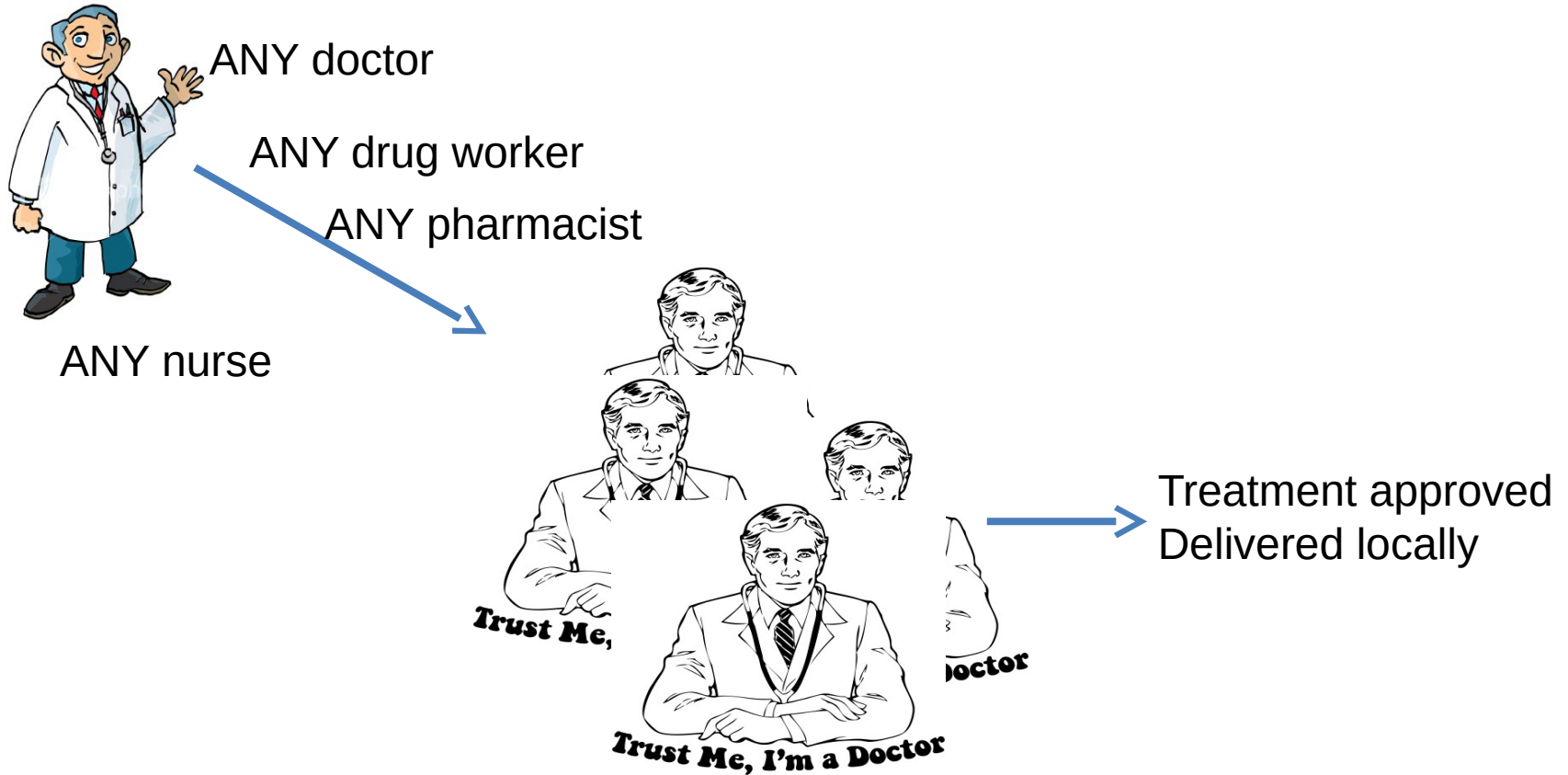
Our health care systems are overloaded

Specialist Commissioning The HCV Model - Networks



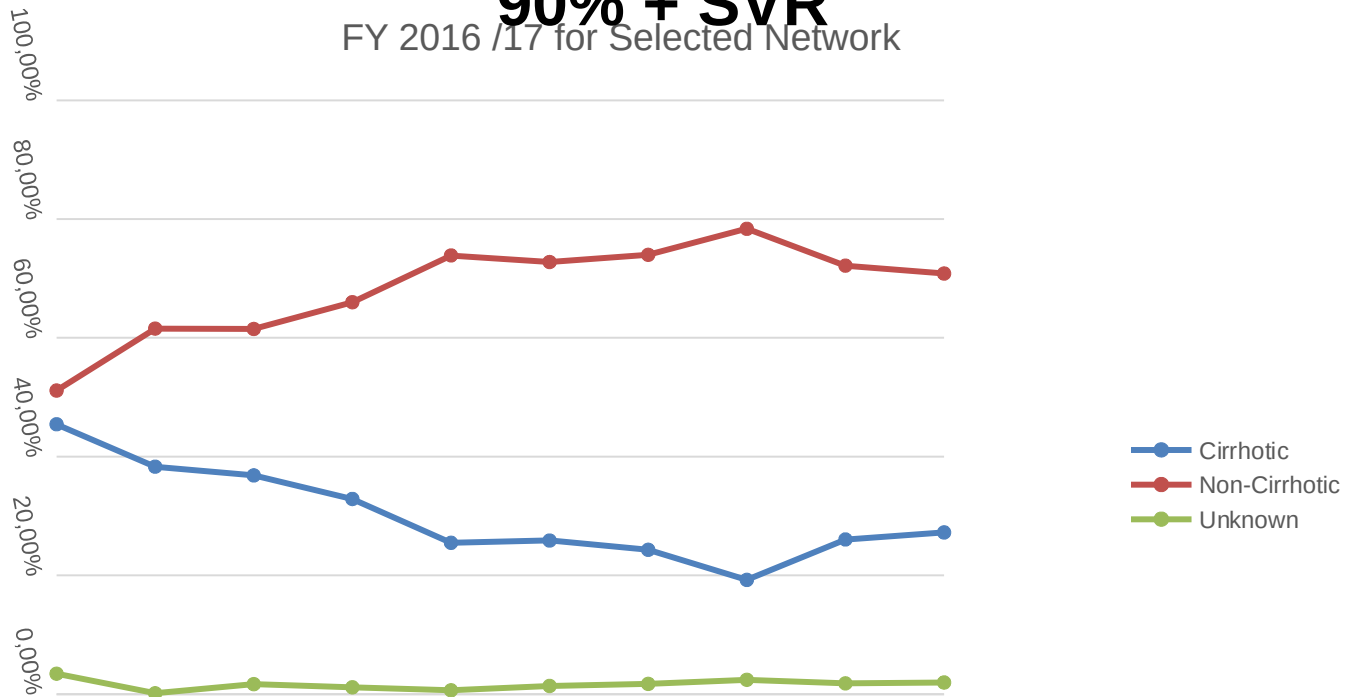
22 Regional networks –

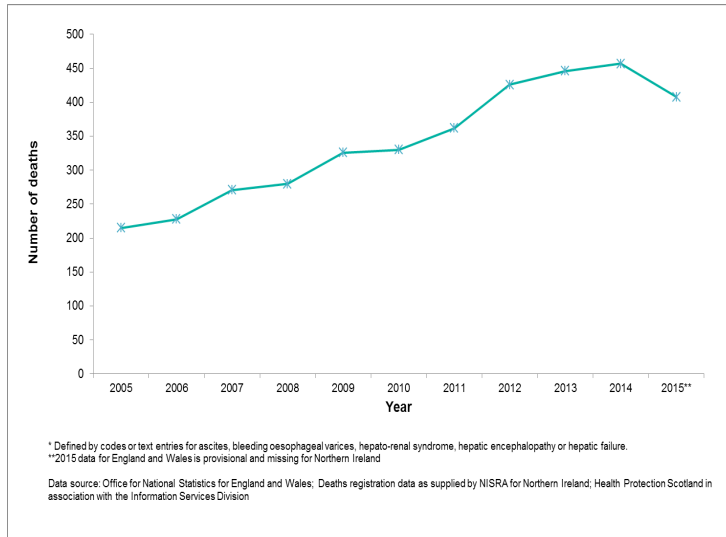
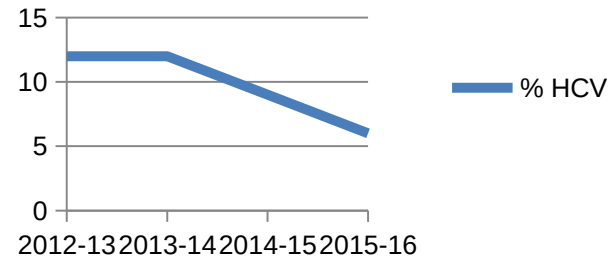

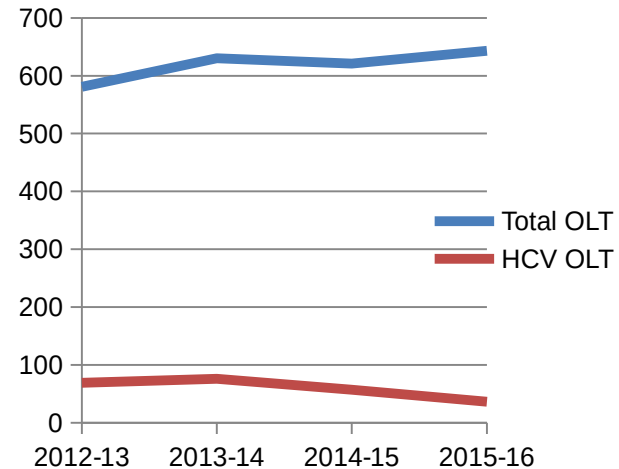


The English Approach - Outcome
