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Current situation of hepatitis C in Spain

- ✓ Prevalence of Viremic cases: 0.37-0.47%
- ✓ Total number of patients: 172,272 to 218,832
- ✓ Estimated Annual Mortality 2,000 to 2,200 deaths
- ✓ Number of liver transplantations
 - 1,159 LTs (2016); linked to HCV 40%: 463 LTs
- ✓ Total number of patients treated by DAAs so far:
 - 81,643 patients (01/2015- 06/2017)
- ✓ Total number of patients treated by DAAs in 2017
 - 29,732 patients (estimated with 2,478 pts per month as average)

Current resources and programs for HCV

- ✓ Current resources provided by Health Authorities (amount in euros/year)
 - Estimated around 200 mill €
- ✓ DAAs available
 - All DAAs available (Vosevi and Maviret since November 2017)
- ✓ Program for screening:
 - Risk groups
 - Not specific programs developed at national or regional levels
- ✓ Program to improve access to treatment:
 - Spanish National Strategic Plan for Hepatitis C since August 2015

Future actions planned

- ✓ To improve screening
 - Evidencing of cost-effectiveness of universal HCV screening in Spain
 - Establishing one-step HCV diagnosis (several initiatives available in some regions)
- ✓ To facilitate access to treatment
 - Focus in prison (around 6,000 patients) and PWID (~23,000 pts) populations
- ✓ Future drugs available
 - No Proceed
- ✓ Other major action
